



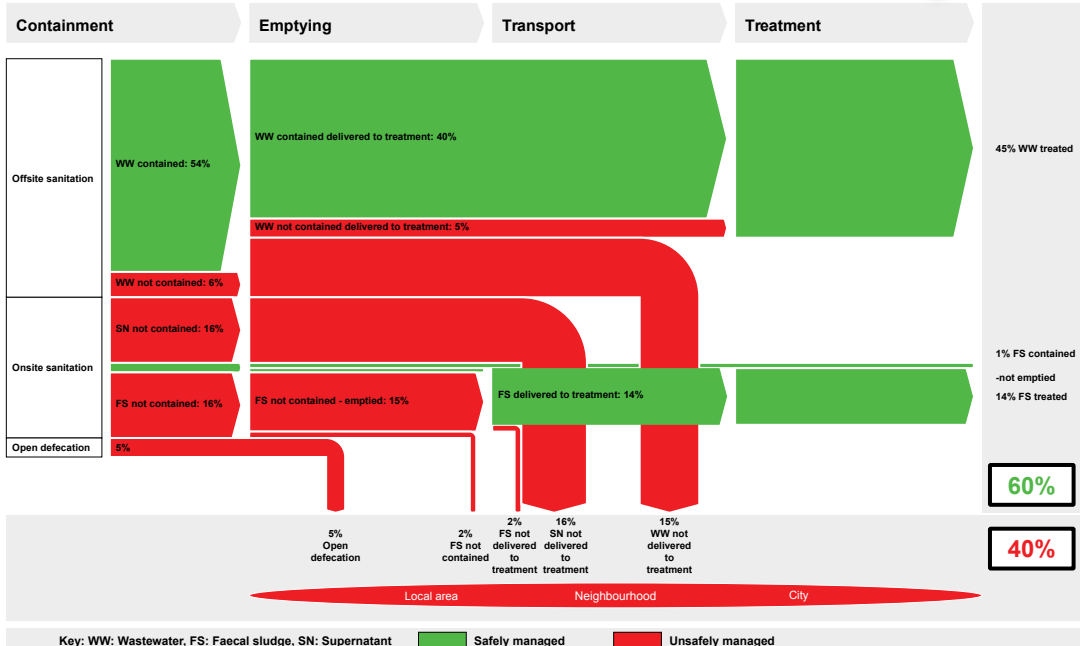
Do you know what Shit Flow Diagrams are?

A Shit Flow Diagram (SFD) is an **easy-to-understand** advocacy and decision-support tool that summarizes and presents what happens to excreta in urban areas in a concise report. An SFD goes beyond this visual representation to also include an assessment of the delivery of sanitation services in the town or city and a record of data sources.

At FSM4 you will have the chance to learn from our experience and to take part in the hands-on workshop on how to prepare an SFD.
